
APPLYING VINYL DECALS





BEFORE INSTALLING

- Don't feel intimidated thousands of people have done this successfully and hassle-free.
- If you don't apply the decal immediately, remove it from the shipping tube and store it laying flat.
 IMPORTANT: Before application, squeegee the entire surface of the Transfer Tape.
 - On decals larger than 28", you may want a second person to help you with installing.



STEP 1

Clean your surface and make sure it's dry.



STEP 2

Line up the decal. (Measure if necessary.)
Place small pieces of tape on the top to hold it in place.



STEP 3

Run a piece of tape across the top of the decal, half on your surface and half on the decal. The tape will act as a "hinge."



STEP 4

Flip the decal up (using the tape hinge) so that the back paper is facing you. **NOTE:** Backing Paper has a grid pattern.



STEP 5

Slowly peel off the Backing Paper starting at the bottom and moving up towards the tape hinge. The decal should stick to the Transfer Tape.



STEP 6

Slowly lower the decal back toward the surface you're applying to. Using a squeegee, firmly smooth down as you lower the decal.



STEP 7

Slowly remove the Transfer Tape from the top. If the decal lifts up while peeling the tape, re-squeegee the surface in the area where it's lifting.



STEP 8

All done! Enjoy your decal!

What is an Etched Glass Decal?

Etched Glass Decals are cut using a special frosted vinyl that when applied, gives the appearance of the image being etched into the glass. Etched Decals are a cost-effective alternative to permanently etching glass the traditional way.

How long will the decal last?

Our decals have a 5 to 7 year durability outside. Decals applied inside can last even longer.

How do I remove the decal?

Peel the decal from the edge and pull until it has been completely lifted. If adhesive residue remains after removal, clean the glass with rubbing alcohol.

PLEASE NOTE: Once a decal is completely removed, it cannot be reapplied.

 When I peel the decal (Step 5), the decal is not releasing from the Backing Paper.

When this happens, lower the decal back into the position it was in Step 3 and squeegee the surface of the decal again, paying particular attention to the spot that did not release from the Backing Paper.
